Instructions for the ICANN online course (1)

1. If you are new to ICANN Learn, visit <u>learn.icann.org</u> and click Create account, as shown with the yellow arrow below.

If you have registered with ICANN Learn before, visit <u>learn.icann.org</u> and click sign in, as shown with the green arrow below.

If you have not signed in to your account recently, click 'forgot password' to update to a more secure password. On the next page, enter your email address as your username. Do *not* tick the box that says "Send the instructions to my recovery email address only."



2. Once you're in the ICANN Learn dashboard, click on Catalogue.



- 3. Once in the Catalogue, select the Newcomer section.
- 4. Once in the Newcomer section, find the SEEDIG Youth School curriculum and click on Enroll.
- 5. You will then be prompted to a list of courses.

6. For the second week of the Youth School (15–21 June), **enroll in the course 200.1 Visual Guide to the History of the Internet.**
